

Directions:

For those of you taking Route 60 from the west with large trailers, Do not turn onto Ballsville Road from Route 60; go to Trenholm. You will not be able to make the turn into the farm if you turn onto Ballsville Road from Route 60.

From Richmond or East: Take 60 west into Powhatan County, approximately 20 miles from Interstate 288 and Route 60. Turn Right onto Trenholm Road Route 629. Continue on Trenholm Road for approximately 2 miles and turn left on Ballsville Road or Route 630. The farm driveway will be about 1.5 miles on the left; there will be a sign at the driveway.

Charlottesville area, take Interstate 64 to Gum Spring Exit 159. Continue route 522 to Route 60 in Powhatan. Turn Right onto Route 60 West. Continue on Route 60 for about 5 miles and turn Right on Route 629 or Trenholm Road. Continue on to Trenholm Road for approximately 2 miles and turn left onto Route 630 or Ballsville Road. Go approximately 1.5 miles, and the farm driveway will be on the left. There is a sign for the farm at the driveway.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

ENTRY FEES: The entry Fee \$25 a class.

** Jumper entries received after 6 pm Thursday will be \$30 a class.

**Hunter entries received after Friday, 6 pm will be \$30 a class

Entries will be accepted the day of the show.

OFFICE FEE \$20.00

COGGINS TEST: All exhibitors must present a negative Coggins Test report on each animal exhibited within one year. This is a Virginia State Law.

Please bring an extra copy to leave with your entry at EACH HORSE SHOW. THANK YOU.

SCHOOLING: Will be permitted only in the ring at designated schooling times, and there will be a warm-up area available. Show management reserves the rights to limit or change schooling if necessary.

ATTIRE: All exhibitors must wear ASTM/SEI protective helmets with harnesses fastened at all times while mounted on the show grounds.

AWARDS: The judge's decisions are always final. Six ribbons per class. Champion Trophy and Ribbon and Reserve Champion Trophy and Ribbon in each division.

We will also provide series Champion and Reserve. Exhibitors must attend at least 3 shows to qualify for series awards. Points will be posted through out the year. **These awards will be given at the last show, and you must be present to receive your award.**

VHSA USEF Rules of personal and professional Conduct, including safe sport, will be followed at the show.

Unsportsmanlike behavior and use of profanity will not be tolerated.

Jumper Divisions

Warm-up one trip over a specified course will be allowed. Unjudged.

Tadpoles - Open to juniors and amateurs only. A course of ground poles. Riders may cross-enter into cross rails only.

Cross rails- Open to riders and horses and ponies. Cross rails not to exceed 18'.

Puddle Jumper: Open to horses and ponies. Horses, ponies, and riders may only cross-enter into any class not exceeding 3' if otherwise eligible. Fences 2'-2'3" Spreads shall not exceed the height of the fence. All classes must be held under USEF Table II 2C Power and Speed or any USEF Optimum Time.

Novice Jumper: Open to horses and ponies in their 1st or 2nd year of showing in Jumper classes at 2'6" or higher as of December 1 of the current show year.

Horses and ponies in this division may only cross-enter into Novice

Children's/Adult Amateur Jumper if the rider is eligible, TB Jumper and Low Jumper, and any other class not exceeding 3'. Fences 2'3"-2'6" Spreads shall not exceed the height of the fence.

Novice Children's/Adult Amateur Jumper: Open horses and ponies ridden by Children and Adult Amateurs in their 1st or 2nd year of showing in Jumper classes at 2'6" or higher as of December 1 of the current show year. Riders may only cross-enter into Novice Jumper, if mount is eligible, TB Jumper and Low Jumper, and any other class not exceeding 3'. Fences 2'3" – 2'6' Spreads shall not exceed the height of the fence.

Low Jumper: Open to horses and ponies. Fences 2' 6" -3 ' Spreads shall not exceed the height of the fence.

Open Jumper: Open to rider's horses and ponies. Spreads shall not exceed the height of the fence. 2'6"

Thoroughbred Jumper: Open to registered Thoroughbreds and those eligible to be registered with The Jockey Club Height of jumps 2'6 -3' Spreads shall not exceed the height of the fence.

Junior/Adult Amateur Jumper Equitation: Open to Juniors and Adult Amateurs. To be judged on hands, seat, guidance, control, and optimum time. Numerical scoring. 2'6" 2'9" or 3' Spreads shall not exceed the height of the fence.

Children's/Adult Amateur Jumper: Open to horses and ponies are ridden by juniors and adult amateur riders. 2'6"-3'3"

Schooling Jumpers: No restrictions on horses or ponies, or riders. 3'3"-3'6" spreads not to exceed the height of the fence.

Modified Jumpers: No restriction on horses/ponies or riders. 3'6"-4' Spreads not to exceed the height of the fence.

California Warm-up: unjudged, only one trip per horse/rider combo **Hunters ONLY**

Lead line: Open to riders seven years and younger as of December 1 of the current show year. Riders are not allowed to cross-enter into any trot classes. Class will be judged 50% on Rider and 50% on horse/pony.

Pre-Short Stirrup Equitation: Open to riders 10 years and under as of December 1 of the current show year. Riders may not cross-enter into canter or jumping classes.

Short Stirrup EQ: Open to riders 12 years and under as of December 1 of the current show year. Riders may not cross-enter into classes with jumps higher than 18". Courses may be trotted.

Short Stirrup Hunter: Open to riders 12 years and under as of December 1 of the current show year. Riders may not cross-enter into classes with jumps higher than 18". Courses may be trotted.

Long Stirrup Hunter: Open to riders 13 years and older as of December 1 of the Current show year. Riders may not cross-enter into classes with jumps higher than 18". Courses may be trotted.

Long Stirrup Equitation: Open to riders 13 years and older as of December 1 of the current show year. Riders may not cross-enter into classes with jumps higher than 18". Courses may be trotted.

Student Equitation: Open to riders in their first or second year of showing over fences at 2' or higher as of December 1 of the current show year. Jumps to be a minimum of 2'. Riders competing in the Student Equitation Division are limited to two years only, whether they compete over fences or not. To be judged as an equitation division. Points go to the rider. Courses may be trotted.

Adult Hunter Pleasure Horse. Open to horses shown with hunter tack on the flat. Judged on manners, suitability, soundness, and way of going.

Junior Hunter Pleasure Horse Open to horses shown with hunter tack on the flat. Judged on manners, suitability, soundness, and way of going.

Pony Hunter Pleasure. Judged on manners, suitability, soundness and way of going. Ponies must be ridden by juniors.

Equitation on the Flat: Open to Juniors and Adult Amateurs. May be split into Juniors 14 and under, Juniors 15-17, and Adult Amateur.

Limit Rider Hunter: Open to horses/ponies ridden by Juniors/Adult Amateurs. Riders may not cross-enter into Equitation over fences classes or any class with fences 2'6" or higher. Ponies must be ridden by juniors. Horses and ponies may cross-enter.

Special Hunter: Open to Horses or Ponies. May trot or canter over fences. Fences 2' or 2' 6"

Green

Pony Equitation: Open to Juniors on ponies. Jump heights: Small 2'; Medium 2'3"; Large 2'6".

Pony Hunter: Open to Ponies 14.2 hands & under-ridden by juniors. Jumps: Small 2'; Medium 2'3"; Large 2'6".

Green Pony Hunter: Green Pony is a pony of any age in his first year of showing in any classes that require ponies to jump the designated height for a green pony. (Ponies are only allowed to show one year as Green Ponies). A pony's green status is not affected if the pony has not been shown at more than four (4) competitions prior to September 1st and if it was not shown at that height after September 1. To accrue VHSA Associate points the height for this division shall be no lower than Small 2', Medium 2'3", Large 2'6".

Children's/ Adult Amateur Equitation: Open to Juniors mounted on horses. Minimum Jump height is 2'6"; not to exceed 3' Open to Adult Amateurs mounted on horses. Minimum Jump height is 2'6"; not to exceed 3'

Children's/ Adult Amateur Hunter: Open to Horses ridden by Juniors/Adult Amateurs. The minimum Jump height is 2'6" not to exceed 3'

Thoroughbred Hunter: The VHSA Associate Thoroughbred Hunter Division is limited to horses who are registered with or are eligible to be registered with the Jockey Club. In order to accrue VHSA Associate points the height for this division shall be no lower than 2'6". The VHSA Associate Thoroughbred Hunter Division may only be combined with the Working Hunter and the Green Hunter. It cannot be combined with any other Division, including non-VHSA Divisions.

Green Hunter: A green horse is a horse of any age in his first or second year of showing in any classes that require horses to jump the designated height for green horses jump height be no lower than 2'6". The Green Hunter Division may be combined with the Green Pony Division if it is not combined with Working Hunter and/or Thoroughbred Hunter at the same show.

Working Hunter: Open to all Horses and Ponies not showing in any Pony Division. Minimum Jump height is 2'9"
