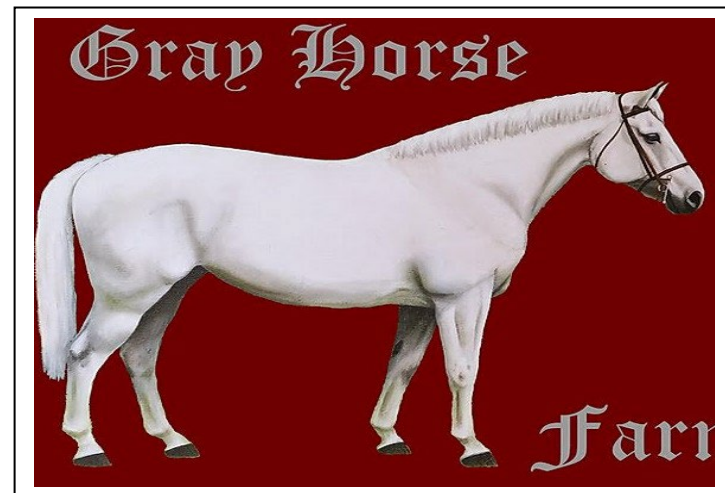

****Covid-19 Information****

TO THE GRAY HORSE FARM EXHIBITORS concerning COVID-19:

We have taken enhanced health and safety measures, for you, our other exhibitors and Staff. You must follow all posted instructions while on these showgrounds. They are from the VHSA, the BHSA and GRHSA and this show.

An inherent risk of exposure to COVID-19 exists in any public place where people are present. COVID-19 is an extremely contagious disease that can lead to severe illness and death. According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, senior citizens and Guests with underlying medical conditions are especially vulnerable.

By visiting this Horse Show you voluntarily assume all risks related to exposure to COVID-19.

The following procedures are strongly recommended:

- The wearing of masks; social distancing; online/pre-entries when possible; limited numbers in Show Office.
- Pre and online entries are due by 6pm the night before the show.
- Please have an open check or cash when registering/picking up numbers.
- A Hard coy of the current Coggins must be left at the horse show office at EACH HORSE SHOW THANK YOU

At ringside, remember to maintain social distancing. There will be no crowding at the gates.

We reserve the right to control the number of people in that area for the safety of all.

If coming to the show, you must be able to assure management that neither you, nor anyone in your household or group has tested positive or has been presumed positive for COVID-19 within the past 14 days; has been advised by a healthcare professional to self-quarantine within the past 14 days; has been in close physical contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 or been presumed positive within the past 14 days; is subject to a quarantine order or recommendation of a healthcare professional that in either case would make it inadvisable to attend a show; has within the past 24 hours exhibited any symptoms including fever of 100.4 or greater, cough, shortness of breath.

For those of you taking route 60 from the west Do not turn onto Ballsville Road from Route 60, go all the way to Trenholm. You will

not be able to make the turn into the farm if you turn onto Ballsville Road from Route 60.

For those of you coming from Charlottesville area, take interstate 64 to the Zion Crossroad exit. You will take Route 15 south to Route 6, that is the most trailer friendly route. This will eventually take you to Cartersville Road, but there is no detour on the other end.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

ENTRY FEES: \$18.00 per class pre-entry, \$20.00 post-entry.

OFFICE FEE \$10.00 Entries available at Horseshowsonline.com

COGGINS TEST: All exhibitors must present a negative Coggins Test report on each animal exhibited within one year. This is a Virginia State Law. Please bring an extra copy to leave with your entry at EACH HORSE SHOW. THANK YOU.

SCHOOLING: Will be permitted only in designated schooling areas from 7:00-8:15 am.

ATTIRE: All exhibitors must wear ASTM/SEI protective helmets with harnesses fastened at all times while mounted on the show grounds.

AWARDS: The judge's decisions are always final. Six ribbons per class. Champion Trophy and Ribbon and Reserve Champion Trophy and Ribbon in each division. Series year-end awards to be presented at the last show.

Puddle Jumper: Open to horses and ponies. Horses, ponies, and riders may only cross enter into any class not exceeding 3' if otherwise eligible.

Novice Jumper: Open to horses and ponies in their 1st or 2nd year of showing in Jumper classes at 2'6" or higher as of December 1 of the current show year.

Horses and ponies in this division may only cross enter into Novice Children's/Adult Amateur Jumper if the rider is eligible, TB Jumper and Low Jumper, and any other class not exceeding 3'.

Novice Children's/Adult Amateur Jumper: Open horses and ponies ridden by Children and Adult Amateurs in their 1st or 2nd year of showing in Jumper classes at 2'6" or higher as of December 1 of the current show year. Riders may only cross-enter into Novice Jumper, if mount is eligible, TB Jumper and Low Jumper, and any other class not exceeding 3'.

Low Jumper: Open to horses and ponies.

Limit Jumper: Open to rider's horses and ponies not jumping higher than 2'6"

Thoroughbred Jumper: Open to registered Thoroughbreds and those eligible to be registered.

Junior/Adult Amateur Jumper Equitation: Open to Juniors and Adult Amateurs. To be judged on hands, seat, guidance, control and optimum time. Numerical scoring.

Children's/Adult Amateur Jumper: Open to horses and ponies ridden by juniors and adult amateur riders.

Schooling, Modified Jumpers: No restriction on horses/ponies or riders.

California Warm-up: unjudged, only one trip per horse/rider combo **Hunters ONLY**

Lead line: Open to riders 7 years and younger as of December 1 of the current show year. Riders not allowed to cross enter into any trot classes.

Pre-Short Stirrup Equitation: Open to riders 10 years and under as of December 1 of the current show year. Riders may not cross enter into canter or jumping classes.

Short Stirrup EQ: Open to riders 12 years and under as of December 1 of the current show year. Riders may not cross enter into classes with jumps higher than 18". Courses may be trotted.

Short Stirrup Hunter Open to riders 12 years and under as of December 1 of the current show year. Riders may not cross enter into classes with jumps higher than 18". Courses may be trotted.

Student Equitation: Open to riders in their 1st or 2nd year of showing 2' or higher as of 12/1/2020. Courses may be trotted.

Pleasure: Judged on manners, suitability, soundness and way of going. Ponies must be ridden by Juniors.

Equitation on the Flat: Open to Juniors and Adult Amateurs. May be split into Juniors 14 and under, Juniors 15-17, and Adult Amateur.

Limit Rider Hunter: Open to horses/ponies ridden by Juniors/Adult Amateurs. Riders may not cross enter into Equitation over fences classes or any class with fences 2'6" or higher. Ponies must be ridden by juniors. Horses and ponies may cross enter.

Low Hunter: Open to horses and ponies. No restrictions on riders.

Special Hunter: Open to Horses or Ponies May trot or canter over fences.

Green Hunter: Open to Horses in their 1st or 2nd year of showing over fences 2'6" or higher and Ponies in their 1st year of showing at 2', 2'3", 2'6" or higher as of 12/1/2020. Will be split if entries warrant.

Pony Equitation: Open to Juniors on ponies. Jump heights: Small 2'; Medium 2'3"; Large 2'6".

Pony Hunter: Open to Ponies 14.2 hands & under ridden by juniors. Jumps: Small 2'; Medium 2'3"; Large 2'6".

Children's/Junior Equitation: Open to Juniors mounted on horses. Minimum Jump height is 2'6"; not to exceed 3'

Children's Hunter: Open to Horses ridden by Juniors. Minimum Jump height is 2'6"

Adult Amateur Equitation: Open to Adult Amateurs mounted on horses. Minimum Jump height is 2'6"; not to exceed 3'.

Adult Amateur Hunter: Open to Horses or Ponies not showing in any Pony Division ridden by Adult Amateurs. Minimum Jump height is 2'6"

Thoroughbred Hunter: Open to registered TBs and horses eligible to be registered. No restriction on riders.

Schooling Hunter: Open to Horses and Ponies; no restriction on riders. Minimum Jump height is 2'6"; not to exceed 3'.

Working Hunter: Open to all Horses, and Ponies not showing in any Pony Division. Minimum Jump height is 2'9"

Ladies Side Saddle: Open to horses and ponies ridden side saddle by junior or senior. Must be ridden in side saddle and habit. Jumps 2'6' or 3'
